TEMPORARY PERMIT

DISPLAY OF INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE

The South Towne Expo Fire Code requires a permit for display of an internal combustion engine on motor vehicles, boats, aircraft or heavy machinery.

The undersigned hereby agrees to abide by all provisions of the Fire Code as follows:

1. Fuel tanks shall not be filled or drained within the building or on the loading dock premise. The fuel tank will also have no more than 5 gallons or ¼ tank of gas, whichever is less.
2. All fuel tank fill openings must be satisfactorily sealed before entering and while in the building.
3. All battery cables must be disconnected from the terminals and remain disconnected while in the building. Loose cable ends must be taped to completely cover all exposed metal.
4. No liquefied petroleum gas (butane, propane, etc.) shall be permitted in the building. A permit may be issued where cylinder is a part of a special display or an integral of the equipment being displayed.
